



# US14-US14 Bypass

## CORRIDOR STUDY

### PROJECT OVERVIEW & OBJECTIVES

The SDDOT has initiated a study of more than 20 miles of the US14 - US14 Bypass corridor to address growing traffic volumes and develop a long-term plan. This study will serve as a guide to the SDDOT and other agencies along the corridor for needed improvements into the future. Study roadways include:

- US14 from the US81 intersection south of Arlington to the US14/US14 Bypass intersection west of Brookings.
- US14 Bypass from the US14/US14 Bypass intersection west of Brookings to the US14/US14 Bypass intersection east of Brookings.

#### DETERMINE:

- ✓ 22nd Avenue intersection configuration for design
- ✓ Potential I-29 Exit 133 interchange configurations
- ✓ Number of US14 Bypass lanes
- ✓ Locations for passing and/or auxiliary lanes
- ✓ Potential bicycle, pedestrian, event traffic, safety, and ITS improvements

#### DEVELOP:

- ✓ Planning-level corridor analysis and long-range plan of the study corridor

#### MEETING PLAN & OBJECTIVES

- Present study overview, timeline, and expectations
- Gather public feedback on current issues and needs

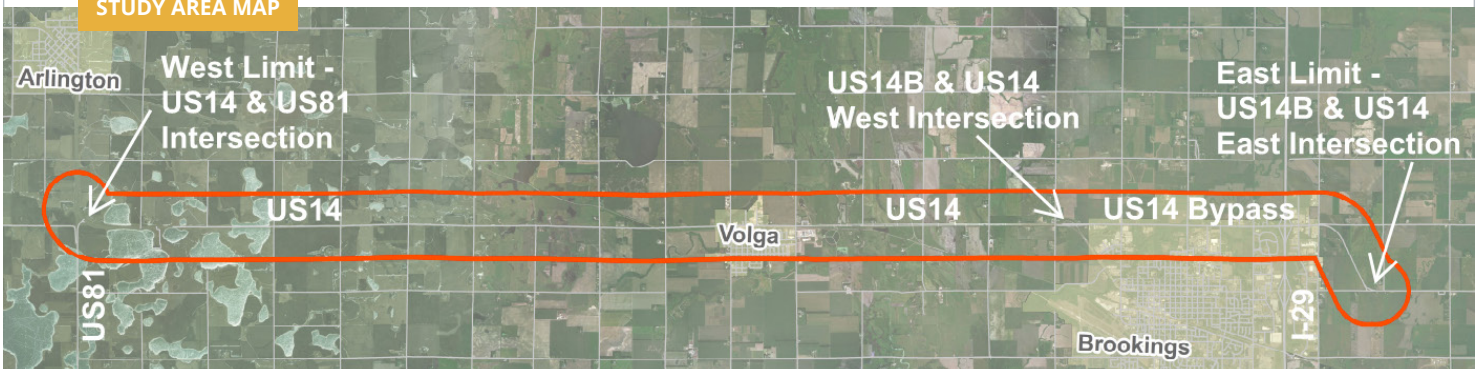
